

- Under 14 years of age: Submit evidence of prior testing
- More than 200 tests accepted
- Neutral and qualified third party
 - School or private psychologist
 - Most public and private school testing accepted

Fees to Join Mensa

- Evaluate prior evidence of testing for qualification
 - One-time nonrefundable \$40.00 fee
 - Fee is waived in November 2022
- Join American Mensa
 - \$79.00/year
 - Family member discounts available (\$53.00/additional)
- Memberships may be renewed annually, every 3 or 5 years, or for life
- Membership in the regional Gifted Youth Program is free and automatic for Mensans under 18 years of age
