We are seeking engineers and artists; makers, tinkerers, and deep thinkers; theoreticians, working professionals, and hobbyists to provide unique and interesting classes for our intellectually gifted students.

Our classes are fun, hands-on, cover a wide variety of subjects, and allow children to stretch their abilities in new areas. Just as important as the curricula, children have a place to come together with more of their gifted peers. They may soar to their own heights, will meet others who share their intensity, ambitions, interests, and abilities, and can interact authentically. Many of our teachers are also gifted.

Class topics we would like to pursue include **architecture**, **ASL**, **collaborative music** (jazz, orchestral, rock), **dinosaurs**, **entrepreneurship** (especially merchandising), **food science**, **nutrition**, **responsible pet ownership**, **sports math** (strategy, stats, fantasy leagues), **spycraft**, **STEM kits**, **strategy card games** (poker, Pokémon, Magic the Gathering), **theater/improv**, and **zoology** (entomology, herpetology, marine biology...). Your idea for a class does not need to be limited to this list. What learning experience would have delighted you as a child?

We would also like to expand upon our popular classes and academic competition teams by offering complementary curriculum or greater depth for older students. These class subject areas include **data analysis**, **Python for a purpose**, **robotics**, and **sewing**.

A class consists of six, two-hour lessons. TSSP is a volunteer-run 501c3, which handles marketing, registration, payment, facilities, and more. Teachers are paid.

To begin teaching spring term, applications must be submitted by 01/04/26. Spring term runs for six Saturdays, 03/14/26 to 04/18/26.
